

Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in March increased \$4.7 billion or 1.5 percent to \$309.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.5 percent February decline and is the first increase since December. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.3 percent, the first decline since November. Year to date, new orders are 2.2 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$304.1 billion, following a 0.8 percent February increase. Year to date, shipments are 1.6 percent above the same period a year ago

Unfilled orders, up for the seventh consecutive month, increased \$4.8 billion or 1.0 percent to \$479.8 billion, following a 0.1 percent February increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.86, up from 2.84 in February.

Inventories increased \$0.2 billion to \$422.4 billion, the eighteenth consecutive monthly increase and the twenty-fifth in the last twenty-seven months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.39, unchanged from February.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in March increased \$4.1 billion or 2.5 percent to \$169.1 billion, revised from the previously published 1.4 percent increase. This follows a 2.5 percent February decline and is the first increase since December. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased \$1.4 billion or 1.1 percent to \$125.7 billion, the first decrease since November.

Transportation equipment, up for the first month since December, had the largest increase, \$5.5 billion or 14.5 percent to \$43.4 billion, as a large increase in aircraft and parts more than offset a decline in motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 12.4 percent February decrease. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the first month since December, increased \$1.2 billion or 4.6 percent to \$28.0 billion, following a 2.1 percent February decline. Stone, clay and glass products, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.1 billion or 1.9 percent to \$7.4 billion, following a 2.9 percent February decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the first month since December, decreased \$1.5 billion or 4.4 percent to \$32.8 billion. This follows a 4.5 percent February increase. Instruments and related products, down two of the last three months, decreased \$1.1 billion or 8.8 percent to \$11.3 billion, following a 5.4 percent February increase. Primary metals, down for the fifth consecutive month, decreased \$0.6 billion or 4.3 percent to \$13.8 billion, following a 0.1 percent February decrease.

New orders for nondurable goods, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$139.9 billion, following a 0.2 percent February decrease. Increases in petroleum and coal products and printing and publishing more than offset a large decrease in paper and allied products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in March decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$163.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease. This follows a 1.3 percent February increase and is the second decrease in the last three months.

Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, had the largest decrease, \$1.3 billion or 3.5 percent to \$36.5 billion, due to motor

vehicles and parts. This follows a 1.2 percent February increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$33.2 billion, following a 4.6 percent February increase. Primary metals, down for the sixth consecutive month, decreased \$0.2 billion or 1.1 percent to \$14.1 billion. Instruments and related products, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.1 billion or 1.2 percent to \$11.7 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.5 billion or 1.7 percent to \$28.1 billion, following a 2.5 percent February increase.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up four of the last five months, increased \$1.0 billion or 0.7 percent to \$140.5 billion, following a 0.2 percent February increase. Petroleum and coal products, up for the fifth consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.7 billion or 5.2 percent to \$15.0 billion. Printing and publishing also increased.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in March increased \$5.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$457.4 billion, revised from the previously published 1.0 percent increase. This follows a 0.2 percent February increase and is the seventh consecutive monthly increase.

Transportation equipment, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$6.9 billion or 3.3 percent to \$218.6 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This follows a 0.1 percent February increase and is the largest since the matching 3.3 percent December 1989 increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the first month since December, decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$73.8 billion. This follows a 1.0 percent February increase. Primary metals decreased \$0.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$28.3 billion, following a 0.4 percent February increase. Instruments and related products, down for the first month since September, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$46.3 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$53.9 billion, following a 1.6 percent February decrease.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in March, up for the eighteenth consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$267.6 billion, following a 0.3 percent February increase. Transportation equipment, up for the third consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 0.7 percent to \$61.2 billion, following a 1.2 percent February increase. Instruments and related products, up for the tenth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$23.4 billion following a 0.4 percent February increase. Primary metals, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$22.1 billion, following a 0.1 percent February increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the first month since June, decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$55.2 billion. Fabricated metal products, down seven of the last eight months, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$24.7 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$154.8 billion, following three consecutive increases. A decline in printing and publishing and apparel and related products more than offset increases in petroleum and coal products and chemical and allied products.

By stage of fabrication, March finished goods decreased 0.3 percent in durables and increased 0.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.4 percent in durables and declined 0.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.2 percent in durables and decreased 0.7 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further letails on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(92), Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1992."




Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages





Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments




