Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in August increased \$4.3 billion or 1.3 percent to \$335.5 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.5 percent July increase and is the third consecutive monthly increase. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.8 percent, following a 1.0 percent July increase. Year to date, new orders are 5.2 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$2.5 billion or 0.8 percent to \$330.4 billion, following a 1.4 percent July increase. This is the first decline since May and the third this year. Year to date, shipments are 5.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up three of the last four months, increased \$5.1 billion or 1.0 percent to \$527.2 billion, following a 0.3 percent July decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.86, up from 2.80 in July.

Inventories, up thirteen of the last fourteen months, increased \$1.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$448.5 billion, following a 0.4 percent July increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, up from 1.34 in July.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August increased \$4.9 billion or 2.7 percent to \$186.5 billion, unrevised from the previously published 2.7 percent increase. This follows a 0.1 percent July increase and is the third consecutive monthly increase.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the first month since May, had the largest increase, \$7.5 billion or 28.4 percent to \$33.8 billion, mostly due to electronic components. This follows a 12.2 percent July decrease. Transportation equipment, up two of the last three months, increased \$2.1 billion or 5.0 percent to \$43.8 billion, as a large increase in aircraft and parts more than offset decreases in the other components. This follows a 2.7 percent July decrease. Instruments and related products, down for the first month since May, decreased \$2.6 billion or 16.8 percent to \$12.8 billion. This follows increases of 15.2 percent in July and 7.4 percent in June. Primary metals, down for the first month since May, decreased \$0.6 billion or 3.8 percent to \$15.6 billion, following a 3.6 percent July increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the first month since May, decreased \$0.4 billion or 1.0 percent to \$34.7 billion. This follows a 6.1 percent July increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, down for the first month since May, decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$148.9 billion, following a 1.0 percent July increase. Declines, led by printing and publishing, paper and allied products, and textile mill products, more than offset increases led by petroleum and coal products.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in August, down for the first month since May, decreased \$2.7 billion or 1.4 percent to \$181.2 billion, unrevised from the previously published 1.4 percent decline. This follows a 1.7 percent July increase.

Transportation equipment, down for the first month since May, had the largest decrease, \$1.0 billion or 2.3 percent to \$43.0 billion, due to aircraft

and parts and motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 3.6 percent Jul increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, also down for the first mont since May, decreased \$0.8 billion or 2.2 percent to \$34.2 billion, followin a 1.9 percent July increase. Instruments and related products decreased \$0 billion or 2.1 percent to \$13.1 billion. This follows increases of 1.1 percein July and 4.3 percent in June. Stone, clay, and glass products, down thre of the last four months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 3.4 percent to \$7.6 billion. This follows a 4.8 percent July increase. Primary metals decreased \$0 billion or 1.3 percent to \$15.4 billion, following increases of 0.9 percent July and 1.7 percent in June. Electronic and other electrical equipment, u three of the last four months, increased \$0.6 billion or 2.0 percent to \$30 billion. This follows a 0.6 percent July decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up for the second consecutive month increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$149.2 billion. This follows a 1 percent July increase. Petroleum and coal products had the largest increase \$0.9 billion or 6.0 percent to \$16.1 billion. This follows a 1.5 percent Julincrease.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in August increased 5.4 billion or 1 percent to 501.3 billion, unrevised from the previously published 1 percent increase. This follows a 0.4 percent July decrease and is the thin increase in the last four months.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, up three of the last four month had the largest increase, \$3.9 billion or 7.6 percent to \$55.3 billion. Th follows a 5.5 percent July decrease. Transportation equipment increase \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$250.5 billion, due to aircraft and parts. The follows a 0.9 percent July decrease and is the second increase in the la three months. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.8 percent to \$73.5 billion following a 0.2 percent July increase. Primary metals, up for the eight consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$32.0 billion following a 2.2 percent July increase. Instruments and related product down for the first month since May, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent \$49.0 billion, following a 4.4 percent July increase.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in August, up thirteen of the last fourtee months, increased \$1.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$282.1 billion. This follow a 0.6 percent July increase. Transportation equipment, up for the twentiel consecutive month, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.9 percent to \$67.5 billion. This follows a 0.8 percent July increase. Primary metals, up for the four consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$25.0 billion following a 0.2 percent July increase. Industrial machinery and equipmen up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent \$60.3 billion. This follows a 0.7 percent July increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up twelve of the last thirteen month increased \$0.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$166.5 billion, following a 0 percent July increase. Led by petroleum and coal products and food ar kindred products, nearly all industries increased.

By stage of fabrication, August finished goods increased 0.8 percent durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.8 percent in durables and 1.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplied decreased 0.3 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Fu details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1 "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1995."




Total Manufacturing

Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


