

## Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in December decreased \$8.6 billion or 2.5 percent to \$336.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.4 percent November increase and is the first decline since May and the third this year. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 1.2 percent, the first increase since September. New orders for 1997 are 5.4 percent above the same period a year ago. year ago.

Shipments increased \$4.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$337.4 billion, following a 0.3 percent November decrease. This is the first increase since September and the seventh this year. Shipments for 1997 are 5.7 percent above 1996.

Unfilled orders, down for the first month since July, decreased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$541.2 billion, following a 2.2 percent November increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.84, down from 2.89 in November.

Inventories, down for the first month since December 1996, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$453.7 billion, following a 0.5 percent November increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.34, down from 1.36 in November.

New orders for manufactured durable goods in December decreased \$10.2 billion or 5.2 percent to \$184.5 billion, revised from the previously published 6.1 percent decrease. This follows a 4.7 percent November increase and is the second decline in the last three months and the fourth this

Transportation equipment, down for the first month since September, had the largest decrease, \$12.0 billion or 21.8 percent to \$43.0 billion; a large decline in aircraft and parts was partially offset by increases led by shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 21.8 percent November increase. Primary metals decreased \$0.6 billion or 3.5 percent to \$15.4 billion, following a 1.8 percent November increase. This is the second decrease in the last three months and the fourth this year. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the first month since August, increased \$1.1 billion or 3.7 percent to \$30.6 billion. This follows a 1.9 percent November decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first month since September, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$34.6 billion. This follows a 1.6 percent November decrease. Stone, clay, and glass products, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.2 billion or 2.6 percent to \$7.7 billion, following a 4.4 percent November decrease. Instruments and related products, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.2 percent to \$13.9 billion. This follows a 1.3 percent November increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.6 billion or 1.0 percent to \$151.7 billion, following a 0.3 percent November decrease. Paper and allied products, chemicals and allied products and food and kindred products had the largest increases; petroleum and coal products had the largest decrease.

### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in December, up for the first month since September, increased \$2.9 billion or 1.6 percent to \$185.8 billion, revised from the previously published 1.5 percent increase. This follows a 0.4 percent November decrease and is the eighth increase this year. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first month since September, had the largest increase, \$1.3 billion or 3.9 percent to \$35.3 billion. This follows a 2.2 percent November decrease. Electronic and other electrical equipment, also up for the first month since September, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.9 percent to \$30.7 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent November decrease.

Instruments and related products, up for the first month since September, increased \$0.3 billion or 2.1 percent to \$13.5 billion. This follows a 3.4 percent November decrease. Stone, clay, and glass products, up for the first month since September, increased \$0.2 billion or 3.3 percent to \$7.8 billion. This follows a 1.3 percent November decline. Fabricated metal products, up for the first month since September, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.3 percent to \$19.6 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent November decrease. Transportation equipment increased 0.1 percent to \$43.9 billion as an increase in motor vehicles and parts more than offset a decrease in aircraft and parts. This follows a 1.6 percent November increase and is the third increase in the last four months.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$151.6 billion, following a 0.2 percent November decrease. Chemicals and allied products, printing and publishing, paper and allied products, and food and kindred products had the largest increases; petroleum and coal products had the largest decline.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in December decreased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$514.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent decrease. This follows a 2.4 percent November increase and is the first decline since July. Transportation equipment, down for the first month since September, declined \$0.9 billion or 0.4 percent to \$261.1 billion, as a large decline in aircraft and parts more than offset increases led by shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 4.4 percent November increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.0 percent to \$73.0 billion, following a slight November increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down for the third consecutive month, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$54.9 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent November decrease. Stone, clay, and glass products, down for the second consecutive month, decreased \$0.1 billion or 1.7 percent to \$6.4 billion. This follows a 0.9 percent November decline. Instruments and related products, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.4 billion or 0.8 percent to \$48.8 billion. This follows a 1.0 percent November increase.

#### Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in December decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$284.0 billion, following a 0.4 percent November increase. This is the first decrease since September and the second this year. Transportation equipment, down for the first month since December 1995, decreased \$1.1 billion or 1.6 percent to \$67.6 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent November increase. Fabricated metal products, down for the first month since September 1996, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$29.1 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$40.5 billion, following a 0.6 percent November increase. Primary metals, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$25.1 billion, following a 0.3 percent November increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up eight of the last nine months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$60.7 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent November increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up sixteen of the last seventeen months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$169.8 billion, following a 0.5 percent November increase. Food and kindred products had the largest increase; petroleum and coal products had the largest decline.

By stage of fabrication, December finished goods decreased 0.5 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased slightly in durables and increased 1.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.3 percent in durables and increased 0.4 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Fu details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1 "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."





Three Month Moving Averages




