Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in February increased \$2.7 billion or 0.8 percent to \$325.9 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.5 percent January increase and December and November decreases of 1.5 percent and 0.5 percent respectively. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 1.6 percent, following a 2.6 percent January increase. Year to date, new orders are 6.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$3.0 billion or 0.9 percent to \$321.5 billion, following a 1.0 percent January increase. Year to date, shipments are 6.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up for the sixth consecutive month, increased \$4.5 billion or 0.9 percent to \$523.6 billion, following a 0.9 percent January increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.94, down from 2.98 in January.

Inventories, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$1.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$441.8 billion, following a 0.5 percent January increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.37, down from 1.38 in January.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in February increased \$2.6 billion or 1.5 percent to \$177.9 billion, unrevised from the previously published 1.5 percent increase. This follows a 3.8 percent January increase.

Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$2.0 billion or 7.1 percent to \$30.4 billion, due to communication equipment and electronic components. This follows a 17.8 percent January increase. Instruments and related products, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.7 billion or 5.1 percent to \$14.0 billion, following a 0.9 percent January increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.9 percent to \$33.1 billion following a 0.9 percent January increase. Fabricated metal products, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.4 billion or 2.1 percent to \$18.4 billion, following a 2.6 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, decreased \$1.7 billion or 4.1 percent to \$40.6 billion, with decreases in all component categories except railroad equipment. This follows a 1.5 percent January increase. Primary metals, down for the first month since October, decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$15.8 billion, following a 5.1 percent January increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$148.0 billion, following a 0.9 percent January increase. Paper and allied products and chemicals and allied products had the largest increases.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in February, up three of the last four months, increased \$2.8 billion or 1.6 percent to \$173.1 billion, revised from the previously published 1.4 percent increase. This follows a 0.9 percent January increase.

Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$1.1 billion or 4.2 percent to \$28.1 billion. This follows a 2.9 percent January decrease and is the first increase since November. Instruments and related

products, up for the first month since November, increased \$0.5 billion or 4.2 percent to \$13.2 billion. This follows a slight January decrease. Fabricated metal products, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.3 billion or 1.8 percent to \$18.1 billion, following a 1.6 percent January increase. Stone, clay, and glass products, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 2.5 percent to \$7.4 billion, following a 5.3 percent January increase. Primary metals, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$15.7 billion, following a 2.6 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$40.0 billion, as increases in railroad equipment and aircraft and parts more than offset a decrease in motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 3.9 percent January increase.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$148.4 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent January increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 1.2 percent to \$32.9 billion. This follows a 1.6 percent January increase and is the third consecutive monthly increase.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in February increased \$4.8 billion or 1.0 percent to \$498.8 billion, revised from the previously published 1.1 percent increase. This follows a 1.0 percent January increase and is the ninth increase in the last ten months.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the second consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$2.3 billion or 4.7 percent to \$52.6 billion, following a 3.0 percent January increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$1.0 billion or 1.4 percent to \$73.4 billion, following a 0.5 percent January increase. Instruments and related products, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$0.7 billion or 1.5 percent to \$48.4 billion. Transportation equipment, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$255.7 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This follows a 1.0 percent January increase. Fabricated metal products, up for the thirteenth consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 1.1 percent to \$24.1 billion. Stone, clay, and glass products, down for the first month since October, decreased \$0.3 billion or 4.0 percent to \$6.5 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in February, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$1.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$279.7 billion. This follows a 0.7 percent January increase. Transportation equipment, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$0.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$70.7 billion. This follows a 2.6 percent January increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$58.1 billion. Fabricated metal products, up for the fifth consecutive month, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$26.5 billion, following a 0.7 percent January increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up for the seventh consecutive month, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$162.1 billion, following a 0.1 percent January increase. Food and kindred products and chemicals and allied products had the largest increases.

By stage of fabrication, February finished goods increased 0.9 percent in durables and decreased 0.1 percent in nondurables. Work in progress increased 0.4 percent in durables and 0.7 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased slightly in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(95), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1995."




Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


Nondefense Capital Goods
