

# Manufacturers' Shipments Inventories, and Orders

#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July increased \$0.7 billion or 0.2 percent to \$330.3 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.7 percent June increase and is the third increase in the last four months. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.8 percent, following a 0.7 percent June increase. Year to date, new orders are 4.9 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments, up three of the last four months, increased \$4.5 billion or 1.4 percent to \$332.9 billion, following a 1.5 percent June increase. Year to date, shipments are 5.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down for the first month since April, decreased \$2.6 billion or 0.5 percent to \$521.4 billion, following a 0.2 percent June increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.80, down from 2.84 in June.

Inventories, up twelve of the last thirteen months, increased \$2.1 billion or 0.5 percent to \$447.0 billion, following a 0.3 percent June increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.34, down from 1.35 in June.

#### New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in July decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent to \$181.0 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease. This follows a 2.9 percent June increase and is the second decrease in the last three months.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, down four of the last five months, had the largest decrease, \$3.9 billion or 13.1 percent to \$26.1 billion, due to electronic components and communication equipment. This follows a 2.6 percent June decrease. Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, decreased \$1.5 billion or 3.5 percent to \$41.4 billion; declines, led by aircraft and parts, more than offset an increase in motor vehicles and parts. This follows an 8.8 percent June increase. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$2.2 billion or 6.6 percent to \$35.3 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent June increase. Instruments and related products, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.6 billion or 12.3 percent to \$15.0 billion, following a 7.4 percent June increase. Primary metals, up eight of the last nine months, increased \$0.6 billion or 3.7 percent to \$16.3 billion, following a 1.1 percent June increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$149.3 billion, following a 0.3 percent June increase. Food and kindred products, textile mill products, and rubber and plastic products had the largest increases.

#### **Shipments**

Shipments of durable goods in July, up six of the last seven months, increased \$3.3 billion or 1.8 percent to \$184.0 billion, revised from the previously published 1.7 percent increase. This follows a 2.7 percent June increase.

Transportation equipment, up six of the last seven months, had the largest increase, \$1.8 billion or 4.1 percent to \$44.2 billion, due to motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts. Industrial machinery and equipment, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.8 billion or 2.2 percent to \$35.0 billion, following a 3.7 percent June increase. Stone, clay,

and glass products, up for the first month since April, increased \$0.3 billion or 3.5 percent to \$7.8 billion. This follows a 0.7 percent June decrease Instruments and related products, up three of the last four months, increases \$0.2 billion or 1.7 percent to \$13.4 billion, following a 4.3 percent Junincrease. Primary metals, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$15.6 billion, following a 1.7 percent June increase Electronic and other electrical equipment, down following two consecutive increases, decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$29.3 billion. Thi follows a 2.9 percent June increase.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up for the first month since April, increased \$1.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$148.8 billion. This follows a sligh June decrease. Food and kindred products, up four of the last five months had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 1.1 percent to \$40.5 billion. Thi follows a 0.4 percent June decline. Rubber and plastic, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.3 billion or 2.1 percent to \$12.5 billion, following a 0.8 percent June increase.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in July decreased \$3.0 billion or 0.0 percent to \$495.1 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.0 percent decrease. This follows a 0.2 percent June increase and is the firs decline since April.

Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, \$3.2 billion or 5.8 percent to \$51.3 billion, following increases of 0.9 percent and 4.1 percent in June and May respectively. Transportation equipmen decreased \$2.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$249.1 billion, mostly due to aircraf and parts. This follows a 0.2 percent June increase and is the fifth decrease in the last six months. Instruments and related products, up eight of the las nine months, increased \$1.6 billion or 3.4 percent to \$48.8 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent June increase. Primary metals, up for the seventl consecutive month, increased \$0.7 billion or 2.2 percent to \$31.8 billion following a 0.9 percent June increase. Fabricated metal products, up for the nineteenth consecutive month, increased \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$26.5 billion, following a 1.6 percent June increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first month since April, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.3 percent to \$73.0 billion, following a 1.6 percent June decrease.

#### Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in July, up twelve of the last thirteer months, increased \$1.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$281.1 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent June increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the fourth consecutive month, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$40.4 billion, following a 0.1 percent June increase. Transportation equipment, up for the nineteenth consecutive month, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.7 percent to \$66.9 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent June increase Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the fourth consecutive month increased \$0.4 billion or 0.7 percent to \$60.2 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent June increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up eleven of the last twelve months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$165.9 billion, following a 0.2 percent June increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase

By stage of fabrication, July finished goods increased 0.6 percent in durables and 0.5 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.7 percent in durables and 0.3 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durables and decreased 0.4 percent in nondurables

One major component of survey error is nonsampling er which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Furl details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(5 "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1995."






Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
