Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in November increased \$8.5 billion or 2.5 percent to \$345.1 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.1 percent October increase and is the sixth consecutive monthly increase. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.3 percent, the second consecutive decline. Year to date, new orders are 5.3 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.3 percent to \$333.1 billion, following a 0.4 percent October decrease. This is the third decrease in the last four months and the fifth this year. Year to date, shipments are 5.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up six of the last seven months, increased \$12.0 billion or 2.3 percent to \$542.5 billion, following a 0.5 percent October increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.88, up from 2.82 in October.

Inventories, up sixteen of the last seventeen months, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.4 percent to \$453.9 billion, following a 0.7 percent October increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, up from 1.35 in October.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in November increased \$8.9 billion or 4.8 percent to \$194.9 billion, unrevised from the previously published 4.8 percent increase. This follows a 0.1 percent October decrease and is the fifth increase in the last six months.

Transportation equipment, up three of the last four months, had the largest increase, \$9.5 billion or 21.0 percent to \$54.6 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This follows a 6.7 percent October increase. Primary metals increased \$0.4 billion or 2.5 percent to \$16.0 billion, following a 6.4 percent October decrease. This is the second increase in the last three months and the eighth this year. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the first month since August, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$30.4 billion. This follows a 4.2 percent October decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.7 billion or 1.9 percent to \$33.9 billion. This follows a 2.2 percent October decrease. Stone, clay, and glass products, down for the first month since August, decreased \$0.3 billion or 3.8 percent to \$7.6 billion. This follows a 1.7 percent October increase. Fabricated metal products, down four of the last five months, declined \$0.3 billion or 1.3 percent to \$19.4 billion, following a 0.6 percent October decrease.

New orders for nondurable goods, down for the first month since August, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$150.2 billion, following a 0.4 percent October increase. Petroleum and coal products and chemicals and allied products had the largest decreases; food and kindred products had the largest increase.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in November, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$183.1 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent decrease. This follows a 1.0 percent October decrease and is the fourth decline this year.

Industrial machinery and equipment, down three of the last four months, had the largest decrease, \$0.8 billion or 2.3 percent to \$33.9 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent October decrease. Instruments and related products, down three of the last four months, declined \$0.5 billion or 3.4 percent to \$13.3 billion, following a 0.5 percent October decrease. Primary metals, down

three of the last four months, decreased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$15.4 billion, following a 0.3 percent October decrease. Fabricated metal products, down for the second consecutive month, declined \$0.1 billion or 0.8 percent to \$19.2 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent October decrease. Transportation equipment increased \$0.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$43.7 billion, as a large increase in aircraft and parts more than offset a decline in motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 0.2 percent October decrease and is the second increase in the last three months. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$30.6 billion. This follows a 2.5 percent October decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, down for the first month since August, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$150.1 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent October increase. Petroleum and coal products and chemicals and allied products had the largest decreases; food and kindred products had the largest increase.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in November increased \$11.9 billion or 2.4 percent to \$516.0 billion, unrevised from the previously published 2.4 percent increase. This follows a 0.5 percent October increase and is the sixth increase in the last seven months.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$10.9 billion or 4.3 percent to \$261.8 billion, mostly due to aircraft and parts. This follows a 0.8 percent October increase and is the third increase in the last four months. Primary metals, up for the eleventh consecutive month, increased \$0.7 billion or 2.0 percent to \$34.2 billion, following a 0.3 percent October increase. Instruments and related products, up for the first month since July, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$48.2 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent October decrease. Fabricated metal products, up for the twenty-third consecutive month, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$27.2 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent October increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down for the second consecutive month, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$55.4 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent October decrease.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in November, up fifteen of the last seventeen months, increased \$0.9 billion or 0.3 percent to \$284.4 billion. This follows a 0.6 percent October increase. Instruments and related products, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$25.1 billion, following a slight October increase. Stone, clay, and glass products increased \$0.2 billion or 1.9 percent to \$8.8 billion. This follows a 1.3 percent October decline and is the third increase in the last four months. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.3 percent to \$40.2 billion, following a 0.2 percent October increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$60.6 billion. This follows a 0.7 percent October increase. Transportation equipments, up for the twenty-third consecutive month, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$68.6 billion. This follows a 1.4 percent October increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up fifteen of the last sixteen months, increased \$0.9 billion or 0.5 percent to \$169.5 billion, following a 0.8 percent October increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$44.4 billion. This is the sixteenth consecutive monthly increase.

By stage of fabrication, November finished goods decreased slightly in durables and increased 1.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 1.0 percent in durables and 1.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.3 percent in durables and 0.9 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. F details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-"Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1982-1995."




Total Manufacturing

Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments


