

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in August increased \$2.9 billion or 0.9 percent to \$337.7 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.1 percent July increase and is the fifth increase in the last six months. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 1.2 percent, the first decline since May. Year to date, new orders are 2.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$1.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$336.7 billion, following a 0.1 percent July increase. This is the third consecutive monthly increase. Year to date, shipments are 3.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up for the first month since April, increased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$530.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent July decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.74, up from 2.72 in July.

Inventories increased \$0.8 billion or 0.2 percent to \$468.4 billion. This is the nineteenth increase in the last twenty months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.39, unchanged from 1.39 in July.

### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August increased \$3.2 billion or 1.7 percent to \$189.8 billion, revised from the previously published 1.6 percent increase. This follows a 2.0 percent July increase and is the fourth increase in the last five months. Transportation equipment, up for the second consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$6.4 billion or 16.1 percent to \$46.2 billion; led by aircraft and parts and motor vehicles and parts, all industries increased. This follows a 1.1 percent July increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down for the first month since May, decreased \$2.3 billion or 6.9 percent to \$30.6 billion, due to electronic components. This follows a 9.2 percent July increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, down for the first month since May, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$147.9 billion. This follows a slight July increase. Declines in petroleum and coal products, printing and publishing, and chemicals and allied products more than offset an increase in food and kindred products.

### **Shipments**

Shipments of durable goods in August increased \$1.8 billion or 0.9 percent to \$188.7 billion, revised from the previously published 1.1 percent increase. This follows a 0.2 percent July increase and is the third consecutive monthly increase. Transportation equipment, up for the first month since March, had the largest increase, \$3.4 billion or 8.5 percent to \$44.0

billion. This follows a 0.7 percent July decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, down three of the last four months, decreased \$1.0 billion or 2.6 percent to \$36.8 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent July decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$148.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent July decrease. Declines in petroleum and coal products, printing and publishing, and chemicals and allied products more than offset an increase in food and kindred products. Petroleum and coal products, down eleven of the last twelve months, decreased \$0.5 billion or 3.9 percent to \$11.7 billion. This follows a 2.1 percent July decline. Food and kindred products increased \$0.7 billion or 1.8 percent to \$41.3 billion, following a 0.2 percent July decline.

### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in August increased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$505.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.1 percent increase. This follows a 0.1 percent July decrease and is the first increase since April. Transportation equipment, up for the first month since April, had the largest increase, \$2.2 billion or 0.9 percent to \$252.7 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent July decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first month since March, increased \$0.8 billion or 1.0 percent to \$73.4 billion, following a 0.2 percent July decrease. Primary metals decreased \$0.5 billion or 1.6 percent to \$31.8 billion. This follows a 2.1 percent July decrease and is the sixth consecutive monthly decline.

### **Inventories**

Inventories of durable goods in August increased \$1.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$296.9 billion, following a 0.2 percent July increase. This is the eighth consecutive monthly increase and the eighteenth in the last twenty months. Transportation equipment, up for the eighth consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$75.9 billion. This follows a 0.6 percent July increase.

Inventories of nondurable goods, down for the first month since December, decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$171.5 billion, following a 0.2 percent July increase. Food and kindred products had the largest decrease, \$0.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$37.1 billion. This follows a slight July decrease and is the third consecutive monthly decrease.

By stage of fabrication, August finished goods increased 0.3 percent in durables and declined 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 1.2 percent in durables and decreased 1.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.5 percent in durables and increased 0.1 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(96), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."




## **Total Manufacturing**

Three Month Moving Averages




