

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in February decreased \$2.9 billion or 0.9 percent to \$334.8 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.6 percent January increase and is the second decrease in the last nine months. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.2 percent, the second increase in the last three months. Year to date, new orders are 3.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$3.8 billion or 1.2 percent to \$337.5 billion, following a 0.9 percent January decrease. This is the second increase in the last three months. Year to date, shipments are 4.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down two of the last seven months, decreased \$2.7 billion or 0.5 percent to \$542.9 billion, following a 0.8 percent January increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.82, down from 2.88 in January.

Inventories increased \$2.5 billion or 0.5 percent to \$457.6 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent January increase and is the thirteenth increase in the last fourteen months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, unchanged from January.

### New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in February decreased \$2.1 billion or 1.1 percent to \$185.4 billion, revised from the previously published 1.7 percent decrease. This follows a 1.6 percent January increase and is the second decrease in the last three months. Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, had the largest decrease, \$3.6 billion or 7.8 percent to \$42.2 billion; a large decrease in aircraft and parts more than offset an increase in motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 7.0 percent January increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the third consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$1.0 billion or 2.8 percent to \$36.4 billion. This follows a 2.3 percent January increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$149.5 billion, following a 0.7 percent January decrease. Textile mill products and petroleum and coal products had the largest decreases.

### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in February increased \$4.7 billion or 2.6 percent to \$187.7 billion, revised from the previously published 2.2 percent increase. This follows a 1.2 percent January decrease and is the second increase in the last three months. Transportation equipment, up for the first month since November, had the largest increase, \$1.4 billion or 3.4 percent to \$44.1 billion, due to motor

vehicles and parts and railroad equipment. This follows a 1.9 percent January decrease. Electronic and other electrical equipment, up two of the last three months, increased \$1.4 billion or 4.6 percent to \$31.0 billion. This follows a 3.2 percent January decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, down three of the last four months, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$149.8 billion, following a 0.5 percent January decrease. Led by petroleum and coal products and textile mill products, decreases were widespread. Tobacco products had the largest increase.

### Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in February decreased \$2.4 billion or 0.5 percent to \$517.2 billion, revised from the previously published 0.6 percent decrease. This follows a 0.9 percent January increase and is the second decrease in the last three months. Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, had the largest decrease, \$1.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$262.6 billion, due to aircraft and parts and shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 1.2 percent January increase. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first month since November, had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 0.6 percent to \$73.1 billion, following a 0.3 percent January decrease.

#### Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in February increased \$1.6 billion or 0.6 percent to \$286.7 billion, following a 0.4 percent January increase. This is the fourth increase in the last five months and the twelfth in the last fourteen months. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, \$1.0 billion or 1.7 percent to \$61.4 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent January decrease and is the fourth increase in the last five months. Primary metals had the largest decrease, \$0.4 billion or 1.4 percent to \$24.8 billion. This follows four consecutive monthly increases.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up for the thirteenth consecutive month, increased \$0.8 billion or 0.5 percent to \$170.9 billion, following a 0.2 percent January increase. Chemical and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$45.7 billion. This follows a 1.6 percent January increase and is the eighteenth increase in the last nineteen months. Food and kindred products, up twelve of the last thirteen months, increased \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$36.6 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent January increase.

By stage of fabrication, February finished goods increased 0.7 percent in durables and 0.4 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.4 percent in durables and 1.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.8 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables.

One major component of survey error is nonsampling error which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(96) "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."




# **Total Manufacturing**

Three Month Moving Averages





Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments




