

Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

July 1998

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July increased \$4.0 billion of 1.2 percent to \$335.2 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.3 percent June increase and is the fourth increase in the last five months. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 1.4 percent, the fifth increase in the last six months. Year to date, new orders are 3.0 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$334.9 billion, following a 0.4 percent June increase. This is the third decline in the last four months. Year to date, shipments are 3.5 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, up for the first month since April, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$529.8 billion, following a 0.7 percent June decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.73, down from 2.74 in June.

Inventories increased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$468.1 billion. This is the eighteenth increase in the last nineteen months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.40, up from 1.39 in June.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in July increased \$3.4 billion or 1.9 percent to \$186.4 billion, revised from the previously published 2.4 percent increase. This follows a 0.1 percent June increase and is the third increase in the last four months.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, up four of the last five months, had the largest increase, \$3.0 billion or 10.0 percent to \$33.1 billion; an increase in electronic components more than offset a decline in communication equipment. This follows a 3.2 percent June increase. Instruments and related products, down two of the last three months, decreased \$0.2 billion or 1.3 percent to \$14.0 billion. This follows a 7.3 percent June increase.

New orders for nondurable goods, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$148.8 billion. This follows a 0.5 percent June increase. Printing, publishing, and allied industries and textile mill products had the largest increases.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in July decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$185.9 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent decrease. This follows a 0.4 percent June increase and is the third decrease in the last four months.

Transportation equipment, down for the fourth consecutive month, had the largest decrease, \$1.0 billion or 2.4 percent to \$39.9 billion. This follows a 6.2 percent June decrease. Fabricated metal products, up for the third consecutive month, increased \$0.4 billion or 2.2 percent to \$20.2 billion. This follows a 0.1 percent June increase.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up for the second consecutive month, increased \$0.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$149.0 billion, following a 0.5 percent June increase. The largest increases were in printing, publishing, and allied industries and textile mill products. Petroleum and coal products had the largest decline.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in July increased \$0.5 billion or 0.1 percent to \$505.4 billion, revised from the previously published 0.3 percent increase. This follows a 0.7 percent June decrease and is the first increase since April. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$2.2 billion or 3.8 percent to \$59.5 billion. This follows a 1.4 percent June decrease and is the first increase since April. Transportation equipment, down five of the last six months, decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$250.7 billion. This follows a 0.6 percent June decrease. Primary metals decreased \$0.6 billion or 1.9 percent to \$32.4 billion. This follows a 1.8 percent June decrease and is the fifth consecutive monthly decline.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in July increased \$0.9 billion or 0.3 percent to \$296.0 billion, following a 0.3 percent June increase. This is the seventh consecutive monthly increase and the seventeenth in the last nineteen months. Transportation equipment, up for the seventh consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 0.7 percent to \$75.1 billion. This follows a 1.6 percent June increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.4 billion or 1.0 percent to \$40.4 billion. This follows a 1.0 percent June decrease and is the third consecutive monthly decrease.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up seven consecutive months, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$172.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent June increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 0.9 percent to \$46.5 billion. This follows a 0.5 percent June increase and is the seventeenth increase in the last eighteen months.

By stage of fabrication, July finished goods increased 0.7 percent in durables and 0.3 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.1 percent in durables and decreased 0.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.2 percent in durables and 0.4 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(96), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."




Total Manufacturing


Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
