

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in June increased \$0.2 billion or 0.1 percent to \$330.5 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.2 percent May decrease and is the third increase in the last four months. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 1.1 percent, the fourth increase in the last five months. Year to date, new orders are 3.1 percent above the same period a year ago; new orders for the second quarter are 0.7 percent below the first quarter.

Shipments increased \$1.0 billion or 0.3 percent to \$334.6 billion, following a 0.6 percent May decrease. This is the first increase since March. Year to date, shipments are 3.9 percent above the same period a year ago; shipments for the second quarter are 0.3 percent below the first quarter.

Unfilled orders, down four of the last five months, decreased \$4.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$529.3 billion, following a 0.6 percent May decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.74, down from 2.79 in May.

Inventories increased \$0.9 billion or 0.2 percent to \$466.6 billion. This is the seventeenth increase in the last eighteen months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.39, down from 1.40 in May.

### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in June decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$182.5 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent decline. This follows a 3.3 percent May decrease and is the fourth decrease this year.

Transportation equipment, down four of the last five months, had the largest decline, \$3.0 billion or 7.2 percent to \$39.4 billion; decreases in motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts more than offset increases in shipbuilding and tanks and railroad equipment. This follows a 4.5 percent May decrease. Instruments and related products, up two of the last three months, had the largest increase, \$0.9 billion or 6.5 percent to \$14.1 billion. This follows a 3.7 percent May decrease. New orders for nondurable goods, up for the first month since March, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$147.9 billion. This follows a 0.8 percent May decline. Food and kindred products and chemicals and allied products had the largest increases.

### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in June increased \$0.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$186.3 billion, revised from the previously published slight increase. This follows a 0.6 percent May decrease and is the first increase since March.

Industrial machinery and equipment, up six of the last seven months, had the largest increase, \$1.2 billion or 3.3 percent to \$37.8 billion. This follows a 0.9 percent May decrease. Transportation equipment, down for the third consecutive month, had the largest decrease, \$2.6 billion or 6.0 percent to \$40.9 billion, mostly due to motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 0.7 percent May decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, up for the first month since March, increased \$0.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$148.4 billion, following a 0.6 percent May decrease. Food and kindred products had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$40.6 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent May decline.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in June decreased \$3.8 billion or 0.7 percent to \$504.7 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.7 percent decrease. This follows a 0.6 percent May decrease and is the fourth decrease in the last five months. Transportation equipment, down four of the last five months, had the largest decrease, \$1.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$251.3 billion, due to aircraft and parts. This follows a 0.4 percent May decrease. Electronic and other electrical equipment decreased \$1.0 billion or 1.8 percent to \$57.1 billion. This follows a 1.1 percent May decrease. Industrial machinery and equipment, down for the third consecutive month, decreased \$0.9 billion or 1.3 percent to \$72.9 billion, following a 0.4 percent May decrease.

### Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in June increased \$0.8 billion or 0.3 percent to \$295.1 billion, following a 0.3 percent May increase. This is the sixth consecutive monthly increase and the sixteenth in the last eighteen months. Transportation equipment, up for the sixth consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$1.2 billion or 1.6 percent to \$74.6 billion. This follows a 1.2 percent May increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.6 billion or 1.4 percent to \$40.7 billion. This follows a 0.3 percent May decrease and seven consecutive monthly increases.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up six consecutive months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$171.5 billion, following a slight May increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$46.1 billion. This follows a 0.5 percent May increase and is the sixteenth increase in the last seventeen months.

By stage of fabrication, June finished goods increased 0.1 percent in durables and decreased 0.1 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.2 percent in durables and increased slightly in nondurables. Materials and supplies increased 0.4 percent in durables and 0.3 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(96), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."






Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
