

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in May decreased \$5.6 billion or 1.6 percent to \$333.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 0.7 percent April increase and is the first decline since February. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 1.5 percent, the second consecutive monthly decrease. Year to date, new orders are 3.7 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$335.5 billion, following a 1.1 percent April decrease. This is the second consecutive monthly decline. Year to date, shipments are 4.2 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders, down three of the last four months, decreased \$2.5 billion or 0.5 percent to \$537.8 billion, following a 0.3 percent April increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.81, down from 2.82 in April.

Inventories increased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$461.6 billion. This follows a 0.4 percent April increase and is the sixteenth increase in the last seventeen months. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.38, up from 1.37 in April.

#### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in May decreased \$4.5 billion or 2.4 percent to \$184.5 billion, revised from the previously published 2.6 percent decrease. This follows a 1.5 percent April increase and is the first decrease since February.

Electronic and other electrical equipment, down for the first month since February, had the largest decrease, \$2.3 billion or 7.3 percent to \$29.4 billion, due to electronic components. This follows a 1.6 percent April increase. Transportation equipment, down three of the last four months, decreased \$1.0 billion or 2.3 percent to \$44.2 billion; decreases, led by aircraft and parts, more than offset increases, led by motor vehicles and parts. This follows a 7.5 percent April increase. New orders for nondurable goods, down four of the last five months, decreased \$1.0 billion or 0.7 percent to \$148.5 billion, following a 0.3 percent April decrease. Food and kindred products had the largest decrease.

#### Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in May decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$186.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.2 percent decrease. This follows a 1.8 percent April decrease and is the second consecutive monthly decrease. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down four of the last five months, had the largest decrease, \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$30.0 billion,

following a 2.2 percent April decrease. Primary metals decreased \$0.3 billion or 1.7 percent to \$14.9 billion. This is the third consecutive decline and follows a 1.5 percent April decrease. Transportation equipment, up three of the last four months, increased \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$44.8 billion; increases, led by motor vehicles and parts and aircraft and parts, more than offset a decrease in shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 2.6 percent April decrease.

Shipments of nondurable goods, down four of the last five months, decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.7 percent to \$148.7 billion, following a 0.2 percent April decrease. Food and kindred products had the largest decline, \$0.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$41.2 billion. This follows a 0.2 percent April decline and is the third decline in the last four months.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in May decreased \$2.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$512.8 billion, revised from the previously published 0.5 percent decrease. This follows a 0.4 percent April increase and is the third decrease in the last four months. Transportation equipment, down three of the last four months, had the largest decrease, \$0.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$259.1 billion, mostly due to shipbuilding and tanks. This follows a 0.3 percent April increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.9 percent to \$57.6 billion. This follows a 2.6 percent April increase and is the first decline since February.

#### Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in May increased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$290.5 billion, following a 0.6 percent April increase. This is the fifth consecutive monthly increase and the fifteenth in the last seventeen months. Transportation equipment, up for the fifth consecutive month, had the largest increase, \$0.3 billion or 0.4 percent to \$70.6 billion. This follows a 1.8 percent April increase. Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.2 billion or 0.3 percent to \$61.3 billion. This follows a 0.1 April increase and is the first decline since January.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up for the sixteenth consecutive month, increased slightly to \$171.0 billion, following a 0.1 percent April increase. Chemicals and allied products had the largest increase, \$0.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$46.1 billion. This follows a 0.6 percent April increase and is the twenty-first increase in the last twenty-two months.

By stage of fabrication, May finished goods increased 0.2 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.3 percent in durables and 0.2 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.1 percent in durables and 0.4 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(96), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."




### **Total Manufacturing**

New Orders and Shipments Three Month Moving Averages




### **Total Manufacturing**

Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments




