

# Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

#### **Summary**

New orders for manufactured goods in August increased \$4.8 billion or 1.3 percent to \$364.7 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 2.5 percent July increase and is the twelfth increase in the last fifteen months. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.8 percent, the sixth increase in the last seven months. Year-to-date, new orders are 5.0 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$5.0 billion or 1.4 percent to \$362.3 billion, following a 0.7 percent July increase. This is the twelfth increase in the last fifteen months. Year-to-date, shipments are 4.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders increased \$2.4 billion or 0.5 percent to \$523.1 billion, following a 0.5 percent July increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.52, down from 2.55 in July.

Inventories decreased \$0.4 billion or 0.1 percent to \$464.6 billion, following a 0.5 percent July increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.28, down from 1.30 in July.

#### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in August increased \$2.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$208.0 billion, revised from the previously published 0.9 percent increase. This is the twelfth increase in the last fifteen months.

Transportation equipment, led by aircraft and parts, had the largest increase, \$2.3 billion or 4.8 percent to \$49.5 billion. This is the fourth consecutive increase. Fabricated metal products, up four consecutive months, increased \$0.7 billion or 3.5 percent to \$21.0 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment increased \$0.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$38.3 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment decreased \$0.9 billion or 2.1 percent to \$39.4 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods, up six of the last seven months, increased \$2.3 billion or 1.5 percent to \$156.6 billion. Petroleum and coal products, chemicals and allied products, and paper and allied products had the largest increases.

#### **Shipments**

Shipments of durable goods in August increased \$3.2 billion or 1.6 percent to \$206.5 billion, revised from the

previously published 1.3 percent increase. This is the thirteenth increase in the last fifteen months. Transportation equipment, led by aircraft and parts, had the largest increase, \$2.6 billion or 5.3 percent to \$51.4 billion. This is the largest increase since August 1998. Fabricated metal products increased \$0.4 billion or 2.1 percent to \$20.8 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.8 percent to \$39.1 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$1.7 billion or 1.1 percent to \$155.8 billion. This is the sixth increase in the last seven months. Petroleum and coal products, up seven consecutive months, increased \$0.6 billion or 3.9 percent to \$15.1 billion. Chemicals and allied products, up four consecutive months, increased \$0.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$35.0 billion.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for durable goods in August increased \$1.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$497.7 billion, unrevised from the previously published 0.3 percent increase. Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$2.8 billion or 4.1 percent to \$71.6 billion, due to electronic components. This is the ninth consecutive increase. Primary metals, up seven consecutive months, increased \$0.4 billion or 1.4 percent to \$31.9 billion. Transportation equipment, led by aircraft and parts, decreased \$1.9 billion or 0.8 percent to \$228.2 billion. This is the fourteenth decrease in the last sixteen months.

#### **Inventories**

Inventories of durable goods in August, down eight of the last ten months, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.3 percent to \$292.7 billion.

Transportation equipment, down eight of the last ten months, had the largest decrease, \$1.4 billion or 1.9 percent to \$71.0 billion. Industrial machinery and equipment, up for the first time since March, increased \$0.2 billion or 0.4 percent to \$60.0 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.4 billion or 0.2 percent to \$171.9 billion. Petroleum and related products, up six consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 3.5 percent to \$11.5 billion.

By stage of fabrication, August finished goods increased 1.0 percent in durables and 0.8 percent in nondurables. Work in process decreased 1.0 percent in durables and 0.8 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.4 percent in durables and slightly in nondurables.

One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. 




Ratio of Unfilled Orders and Inventories to Shipments
