

Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in October decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.2 percent to \$360.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census reported today. This follows a 1.0 percent September decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.5 percent. Year-to-date, new orders are 5.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$1.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$360.3 billion, following a 0.9 percent September decrease. This is the fifth increase in the last six months. Year-to-date, shipments are 4.8 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$0.3 billion to \$525.2 billion, following a 0.4 percent September increase. This is the first decrease since June. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 2.56, down from 2.58 in September.

Inventories increased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$467.0 billion, following a 0.3 percent September increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.30, unchanged from September.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in October decreased \$2.5 billion or 1.2 percent to \$201.9 billion, revised from the previously published 1.3 percent decrease.

Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest decrease, \$4.0 billion or 10.4 percent to \$34.7 billion. This is the first decrease since May 1999 and the largest since July 1997. Industrial machinery and equipment increased \$0.7 billion or 1.7 percent to \$39.7 billion. Transportation equipment, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.6 billion or 1.3 percent to \$47.2 billion.

New orders for nondurable goods, up five of the last six months, increased \$1.6 billion or 1.0 percent to \$158.1 billion. Paper and allied products and chemicals and allied products had the largest increases.

Shipments

Shipments of durable goods in October increased \$0.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$202.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.7 percent increase. This is the fifth increase in the last six months.

Industrial machinery and equipment had the largest increase, \$1.9 billion or 4.9 percent to \$39.6 billion. Transportation equipment decreased \$0.8 billion or 1.7 percent to \$47.7 billion. Electronic and other electrical equipment, down three consecutive months, decreased \$0.5 billion or 1.4 percent to \$34.8 billion.

Shipments of nondurable goods increased \$0.9 billion or 0.6 percent to \$157.7 billion. This is the sixth consecutive increase. Chemicals and allied products, up six consecutive months, increased \$0.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$35.5 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for durable goods in October decreased \$0.7 billion or 0.1 percent to \$499.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.5 percent decrease. This is the first decrease since June. Transportation equipment, down nine consecutive months, had the largest decrease, \$0.5 billion or 0.2 percent to \$225.7 billion. Instruments and related products, down five consecutive months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.7 percent to \$46.0 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of durable goods in October increased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$293.2 billion.

Electronic and other electrical equipment had the largest increase, \$0.4 billion or 1.1 percent to \$42.0 billion. This is the eighth increase in the last nine months and the largest since February. Transportation equipment, down seven of the last eight months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$70.4 billion.

Inventories of nondurable goods, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$1.1 billion or 0.6 percent to \$173.9 billion. Food and kindred products had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.4 percent to \$38.7 billion.

By stage of fabrication, October finished goods increased 0.4 percent in durables and 1.0 percent in nondurables. Work in process increased 0.2 percent in durables and 1.1 percent in nondurables. Materials and supplies decreased 0.2 percent in durables and 0.1 percent in nondurables.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Fu details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1 "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1987-1996."




Total Manufacturing

Three Month Moving Averages




