Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in July increased \$5.3 billion or 1.6 percent to \$329.4 billion, the Department of Commerce, Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.9 percent June increase and was at the highest level since May 2001. Year to date, new orders for 2003 were 2.1 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$8.3 billion or 2.5 percent to \$336.9 billion. This followed a 1.5 percent June increase and was the largest percent increase since February 2001. Year to date, shipments for 2003 were 1.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders decreased \$2.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$485.3 billion, following five consecutive increases including a 0.3 percent June increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 3.94, down from 4.07 in June. This was the lowest ratio since August 2000.

Inventories decreased \$2.3 billion or 0.5 percent to \$440.4 billion, following a 0.3 percent June decrease. This was the lowest level since September 1997. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.31, down from 1.35 in June. This tied the ratio for January 2000 and was at the lowest ratio since the series began in January 1992.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in July, up three consecutive months, increased \$1.7 billion or 1.0 percent to \$173.9 billion, revised from the previously published \$174.0 billion.

Fabricated metal products had the largest increase, \$0.6 billion or 3.0 percent to \$20.5 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$3.6 billion or 2.4 percent to \$155.4 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in July, up three consecutive months, increased \$4.7 billion or 2.7 percent to \$181.5 billion, revised from the previously published 2.6 percent increase.

Transportation equipment, up three consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$2.1 billion or 4.1 percent to \$53.1 billion, led by motor vehicles and parts, which increased by \$1.9 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up three consecutive months, increased \$3.6 billion or 2.4 percent to \$155.4 billion. Basic chemicals had the largest increase, \$3.0 billion or 8.2 percent to \$40.0 billion, led by pharmaceuticals and medicines, which increased by \$2.5 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders of manufactured durable goods in July decreased \$2.1 billion or 0.4 percent to \$485.3 billion, revised from the previously published \$485.5 billion.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$1.2 billion or 0.5 percent to \$246.3 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which decreased by \$0.4 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in July decreased \$2.2 billion or 0.8 percent to \$264.0 billion, revised from the previously published 0.9 percent decrease. This was the twenty-ninth decrease over the past thirty months.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$1.1 billion or 1.6 percent to \$67.1 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which decreased by \$1.3 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$176.4 billion. Plastic and rubber products had the largest decrease, \$0.3 billion or 1.3 percent to \$20.3 billion.

By stage of fabrication, July materials and supplies decreased 1.5 percent in durable goods and 1.3 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.2 percent in durable goods and increased 0.8 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods decreased 0.9 percent in durable goods and increased 0.5 percent in nondurable goods.

One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(02), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2002."
