



Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: June 2003

The advance report on durable goods for July is scheduled for August 26, 2003 at 8:30 a.m. and the full report on September 4, 2003 at 10:00 a.m.
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Figures in text, other than year to date, are in seasonally adjusted current dollars and **exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing**.

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in June increased \$5.5 billion or 1.7 percent to \$326.0 billion, the Department of Commerce, Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 0.3 percent May increase. Year to date, new orders for 2003 were 2.6 percent above the same period a year ago.

Shipments increased \$3.5 billion or 1.1 percent to \$324.6 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent May increase. Year to date, shipments for 2003 were 1.4 percent above the same period a year ago.

Unfilled orders increased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$478.1 billion, following a 0.1 percent May decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 4.01, down from 4.03 in May.

Inventories, down four consecutive months, decreased \$0.8 billion or 0.2 percent to \$430.5 billion, following a 0.2 percent May decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.33, down from 1.34 in May.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in June increased \$4.4 billion or 2.6 percent to \$173.4 billion, revised from the previously published 2.1 percent increase. This was the largest percent increase since July 2002.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$2.3 billion or 4.7 percent to \$51.2 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which increased by \$1.0 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$1.1 billion or 0.7 percent to \$152.5 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in June increased \$2.4 billion or 1.4 percent to \$172.1 billion, revised from the previously published 1.3 percent increase.

Transportation equipment had the largest increase, \$1.4 billion or 2.8 percent to \$50.9 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which increased by \$0.7 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods increased \$1.1 billion or 0.7 percent to \$152.5 billion. Food products had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.3 percent to \$38.5 billion, led by meat, poultry, and seafood products, which increased by \$0.4 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders of manufactured durable goods in June increased \$1.4 billion or 0.3 percent to \$478.1 billion, revised from the previously published 0.1 percent increase.

Computers and electronic products had the largest increase, \$0.8 billion or 0.8 percent to \$111.7 billion, led by electromedical, measuring, and control instruments, which increased by \$0.8 billion. Unfilled orders for computers and electronic products have increased seven consecutive months.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in June decreased \$1.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$260.8 billion, unrevised from the previously published decrease. This was the twenty-eighth decrease over the past twenty-nine months.

Transportation equipment had the largest decrease, \$0.6 billion or 0.9 percent to \$73.0 billion, led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which decreased by \$0.8 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, at the highest level since June 2001, increased \$0.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$169.7 billion. Petroleum and coal products had the largest increase, \$0.3 billion or 2.3 percent to \$13.6 billion.

By stage of fabrication, June materials and supplies decreased 0.7 percent in durable goods and 0.9 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 1.3 percent in durable goods and increased 1.6 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.4 percent in durable goods and 0.9 percent in nondurable goods.

Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(01), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2001."

NOTE: The five year and the twelve month revisions are the differences between the month-to-month percent changes of the preliminary and final estimates. The monthly averages are the simple averages of the absolute values of the differences for the months specified. The advance to final percent change revisions for the durable goods industries are shown in the advance report for the month.

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), and end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value). The M3 includes approximately 4,000 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 59 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,000 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,000 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source.

- adjusting new and unfilled orders to be consistent with the benchmarked shipments and inventory data;
- newly introduced data for semiconductor manufacturing from March 2002 forward;
- correcting monthly data for late receipts, reclassifications of reported data, and revisions to previously reported data; and
- updating the seasonal adjustment factors for all series.
