



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Figures in text, other than year-to-date, are in seasonally adjusted current dollars. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in March increased \$14.9 billion or 4.3 percent to \$360.7 billion, the Department of Commerce, Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.1 percent February increase and is the third increase in the last four months.

Shipments increased \$13.1 billion or 3.8 percent to \$361.3 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent February decrease. This was the largest percent increase in shipments since the current series began in 1992.

Unfilled orders, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$6.3 billion or 1.2 percent to \$516.8 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent February increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 3.91, down from 4.00 in February.

Inventories, up five of the last six months, increased \$1.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$444.3 billion. This followed a 0.6 percent February increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.23, down from 1.27 in February.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in March increased \$9.4 billion or 5.0 percent to \$195.8 billion, revised from the previously published \$6.3 billion increase.

Transportation equipment, up three of the last four months, had the largest increase, \$2.3 billion or 4.1 percent to \$57.3 billion. Fabricated metal products increased \$1.9 billion or 8.6 percent to \$23.8 billion. This was the largest percent increase in fabricated metal products since December 1993.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$5.6 billion or 3.5 percent to \$165.0 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in March, up six of the last seven months, increased \$7.6 billion or 4.0 percent to \$196.4 billion, revised from the previously published \$6.0 billion increase.

Fabricated metal products had the largest increase, \$2.1 billion or 10.3 percent to \$22.7 billion. This was the largest percent increase in fabricated metal products since the current series began in 1992. Primary metals, up seven consecutive months, increased \$1.2 billion or 9.9 percent to \$13.2 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up six of the last seven months, increased \$5.6 billion or 3.5 percent to \$165.0 billion. Petroleum and coal products, up four of the last five months, had the largest increase, \$1.5 billion or 6.2 percent to \$25.9 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders of manufactured durable goods in March, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$6.3 billion or 1.2 percent to \$516.8 billion, revised from the previously published \$4.3 billion increase.

Computers and electronic products had the largest increase, \$1.9 billion or 1.4 percent to \$132.4 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in March, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.9 billion or 0.3 percent to \$265.4 billion, revised from the previously published \$0.3 billion increase.

Primary metals, up five consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.3 billion or 1.8 percent to \$18.1 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up four of the last five months, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent to \$178.8 billion. Basic chemicals, up five of the last six months, had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$54.8 billion.

By stage of fabrication, March materials and supplies increased 1.0 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.3 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.2 percent in durable goods and increased 1.0 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.3 percent in durable goods and 0.5 percent in nondurable goods.

Note: Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response, and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design, methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-1(02), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2002."

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 3,500 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 59 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 3,500 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 3,500 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source.
