Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders October 2010

The Census Bureau identified a processing error that occurred with the October 2010 Full Report affecting "Table 6 - Value of Manufacturers' Inventories, by Stage of Fabrication, by Industry Group" for seasonally adjusted data for September and the corresponding Total Inventory NAICS Historic time series. Although the affect on the data is minor, approximately \$74 million was improperly distributed across the stages of fabrication portion of the inventory data for the Machinery industry and the corresponding aggregates of "Durable Goods Industries" and "All Manufacturing Industries". Total inventory for this report is not affected. The error in the distribution of the inventories across these categories was due to an error in the program sequencing that distributes inventories across the stages of fabrication and it has since been corrected. Effective December 16, 2010, all data have been corrected.

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in October, down following three consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$3.6 billion or 0.9 percent to \$420.1 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 3.0 percent September increase. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 0.2 percent.

Shipments, up three of the last four months, increased \$1.5 billion or 0.3 percent to \$421.0 billion. This followed a 0.7 percent September increase.

Unfilled orders, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$5.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$821.6 billion. This followed a 1.3 percent September increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 5.76, up from 5.67 in September.

Inventories, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$4.7 billion or 0.9 percent to \$538.2 billion. This followed a 1.1 percent September increase. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.28, up from 1.27 in September.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in October, down two of the last three months, decreased \$6.9 billion or 3.4 percent to \$195.7 billion, revised from the previously published 3.3 percent decrease. This followed a 4.9 percent September increase.

Transportation equipment, also down two of the last three months, had the largest decrease, \$2.8 billion or 5.2 percent to \$52.3 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$3.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$224.4 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in October, also down two of the last three months, decreased \$1.8 billion or 0.9 percent to \$196.6 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a slight September increase.

Machinery, down following two consecutive monthly increases, had the largest decrease, \$0.9 billion or 3.7 percent to \$24.6 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up three consecutive months, increased \$3.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$224.4 billion. This followed a 1.4 percent September increase. Petroleum and coal products, also up three consecutive months, drove the increase, up \$3.8 billion or 7.5 percent to \$54.7 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in October, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$5.2 billion or 0.6 percent to \$821.6 billion, revised from the previously published 0.7 percent increase. This followed a 1.3 percent September increase.

Transportation equipment, up two consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$3.7 billion or 0.8 percent to \$484.2 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in October, up ten consecutive months, increased \$1.5 billion or 0.5 percent to \$316.9 billion, revised from the previously published 0.4 percent increase. This followed a 0.7 percent September increase.

Machinery, up eight consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.5 billion or 0.9 percent to \$52.4 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up three of the last four months, increased \$3.2 billion or 1.5 percent to \$221.3 billion. This followed a 1.7 percent September increase. Petroleum and coal products, also up three of the last four months, led the increase, up \$1.6 billion or 3.6 percent to \$44.7 billion.

By stage of fabrication, October materials and supplies increased 0.5 percent in durable goods and 1.0 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.4 percent in durable goods and 2.8 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.6 percent in durable goods and 1.2 percent in nondurable goods.

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 4,300 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 64 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,300 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,300 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
