Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders January 2015

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in January, down six consecutive months, decreased \$0.9 billion or 0.2 percent to \$470.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 3.5 percent December decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 1.8 percent.

Shipments, down five of the last six months, decreased \$9.8 billion or 2.0 percent to \$479.1 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent December decrease.

Unfilled orders, down two consecutive months, decreased \$2.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,163.4 billion. This followed a 0.9 percent December decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.68, up from 6.65 in December.

Inventories, down two consecutive months, decreased \$2.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$650.5 billion. This followed a 0.4 percent December decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.36, up from 1.34 in December.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in January, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, increased \$6.5 billion or 2.8 percent to \$236.3 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 3.7 percent December decrease.

Transportation equipment, also up following two consecutive monthly decreases, led the increase, \$6.4 billion or 9.7 percent to \$72.6 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$7.4 billion or 3.1 percent to \$233.7 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in January, down three of the last four months, decreased \$2.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$245.4 billion, revised from the previously published 1.1 percent decrease. This followed a 1.5 percent December increase.

Transportation equipment, down two of the last three months, led the decrease, \$0.9 billion or 1.1 percent to \$74.4 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, down eight of the last nine months, decreased \$7.4 billion or 3.1 percent to \$233.7 billion. This followed a 3.3 percent December decrease. Petroleum and coal products, down seven consecutive months, led the decrease, \$5.9 billion or 11.1 percent to \$47.3 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in January, down two consecutive months, decreased \$2.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,163.4 billion, unchanged from the previously published decrease. This followed a 0.9 percent December decrease.

Transportation equipment, also down two consecutive months, led the decrease, \$1.9 billion or 0.3 percent to \$736.8 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in January, up twenty-one of the last twenty-two months, increased \$1.7 billion or 0.4 percent to \$412.4 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis in 1992 and followed a 0.5 percent December increase.

Transportation equipment, also up twenty-one of the last twenty-two months, led the increase, \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$134.3 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, down eight consecutive months, decreased \$4.2 billion or 1.7 percent to \$238.1 billion. This followed a 2.0 percent December decrease. Petroleum and coal products, also down eight consecutive months, led the decrease, \$3.9 billion or 10.2 percent to \$34.6 billion.

By stage of fabrication, January materials and supplies decreased slightly in durable goods and decreased 2.3 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process increased 0.7 percent in durable goods and decreased 2.7 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.5 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.9 percent in nondurable goods.

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 4,800 reporting units that represent approximately 3,000 companies and provide an indication of month-to-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category.

The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 61 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census, and these companies include almost two-thirds of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2012 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 54 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.

Benchmark notice

Revised historical data from the Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) Survey will be issued on May 14, 2015. These revisions result from benchmarking the shipments and inventories data to the 2012 Economic Census and the 2013 Annual Survey of Manufactures (ASM) data on a 2012 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) basis, as well as revised ASM benchmarks for prior years on a 2007 NAICS basis; incorporating the unfilled orders to shipments ratios obtained from the 2013/2012 and 2012/2011 Manufacturers' Unfilled Orders Surveys by applying these ratios to the respective Census or ASM shipments data, as well as incorporating revised unfilled orders to shipments ratios for prior years; adjusting the new orders data to be consistent with the benchmarked shipments and unfilled orders data; correcting monthly data for late receipts, reclassifications of reported data, and revisions to previously reported data; and updating the seasonally adjusted data based on the results of benchmarking and the recent annual review of the seasonal adjustment models. These revisions will span the seasonally adjusted data for January 1997 through March 2015 and the data not seasonally adjusted for January 2001 through March 2015. An updated Press Release will contain revised monthly tables for January 2015 through March 2015 on a 2012 NAICS basis, which will be the new basis for publishing data from the M3 Survey starting with the April 2015 Advance Report on Durable Goods.
