Full Report on Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders November 2015

Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in November, down three of the last four months, decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.2 percent to \$472.2 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.3 percent October increase.

Shipments, up following four consecutive monthly decreases, increased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$475.3 billion. This followed a 0.7 percent October decrease.

Unfilled orders, up two consecutive months, increased \$1.9 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,193.9 billion. This followed a 0.3 percent October increase. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.92, down from 6.96 in October.

Inventories, down five consecutive months, decreased \$1.7 billion or 0.3 percent to \$641.3 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent October decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.35, down from 1.36 in October.

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in November, down three of the last four months, decreased less than \$0.1 billion or virtually unchanged to \$238.6 billion, down from the previously published virtually unchanged increase. This followed a 2.8 percent October increase.

Primary metals, down five of the last six months, drove the decrease, \$0.6 billion or 2.9 percent to \$19.5 billion.

New orders for manufactured nondurable goods decreased \$1.0 billion or 0.4 percent to \$233.6 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in November, up two of the last three months, increased \$2.0 billion or 0.8 percent to \$241.7 billion, down from the previously published 0.9 percent increase. This followed a 1.2 percent October decrease.

Transportation equipment, also up two of the last three months, drove the increase, \$2.0 billion or 2.6 percent to \$80.6 billion.

Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, down five consecutive months, decreased \$1.0 billion or 0.4 percent to \$233.6 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent October decrease. Petroleum and coal products, also down five consecutive months, led the decrease, \$0.7 billion or 1.5 percent to \$42.1 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in November, up two consecutive months, increased \$1.9 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,193.9 billion, unchanged from the previously published 0.2 percent increase. This followed a 0.3 percent October increase.

Transportation equipment, also up two consecutive months, led the increase, \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$799.3 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in November, down six of the last seven months, decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.3 percent to \$395.3 billion, unchanged from the previously published 0.3 percent decrease. This followed a 0.3 percent October decrease.

Transportation equipment, down four of the last five months, led the decrease, \$0.9 billion or 0.7 percent to \$129.6 billion.

Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, down four of the last five months, decreased \$0.3 billion or 0.1 percent to \$246.0 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent October increase. Petroleum and coal products, also down four of the last five months, led the decrease, \$0.3 billion or 1.0 percent to \$33.8 billion.

By stage of fabrication, November materials and supplies decreased 0.5 percent in durable goods and increased 0.1 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.6 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.8 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.3 percent in durable goods and was virtually unchanged in nondurable goods.

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 4,800 reporting units that represent approximately 3,000 companies and provide an indication of month-to-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category.

The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 61 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census, and these companies include almost two-thirds of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2012 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 54 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2012 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
