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
# MONTHLY FULL REPORT ON MANUFACTURERS' SHIPMENTS, INVENTORIES AND ORDERS OCTOBER 2020

**December 4, 2020** — The U.S. Census Bureau announces the October full report on manufacturers' shipments, inventories and orders:





#### Summary

New orders for manufactured goods in October, up six consecutive months, increased \$4.9 billion or 1.0 percent to \$480.8 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau reported today. This followed a 1.3 percent September increase. Shipments, also up six consecutive months, increased \$4.9 billion or 1.0 percent to \$488.6 billion. This followed a 0.5 percent September increase. Unfilled orders, down seven of the last eight months, decreased \$2.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,073.3 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent September decrease. The unfilled orders-to-shipments ratio was 6.38, down from 6.57 in September. Inventories, up two of the last three months, increased \$1.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$687.3 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent September decrease. The inventories-to-shipments ratio was 1.41, down from 1.42 in September.

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#### **New Orders**

New orders for manufactured durable goods in October, up six consecutive months, increased \$3.2 billion or 1.3 percent to \$241.0 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 2.1 percent September increase. Transportation equipment, up five of the last six months, led the increase, \$1.1 billion or 1.4 percent to \$77.3 billion. New orders for manufactured nondurable goods increased \$1.7 billion or 0.7 percent to \$239.8 billion.

## Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in October, up five of the last six months, increased \$3.2 billion or 1.3 percent to \$248.8 billion, unchanged from the previously published increase. This followed a 0.5 percent September increase. Fabricated metal products, also up five of the last six months, led the increase, \$0.7 billion or 2.4 percent to \$30.9 billion. Shipments of manufactured nondurable goods, up six consecutive months, increased \$1.7 billion or 0.7 percent to \$239.8 billion. This followed a 0.5 percent September increase. Chemical products, up seven of the last eight months, led the increase, \$0.8 billion or 1.1 percent to \$69.4 billion.

#### **Unfilled Orders**

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in October, down seven of the last eight months, decreased \$2.6 billion or 0.2 percent to \$1,073.3 billion, up from the previously published 0.3 percent decrease. This followed a 0.2 percent September decrease. Transportation equipment, down eight consecutive months, drove the decrease, \$4.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$717.1 billion.

## **Inventories**

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in October, up two consecutive months, increased \$1.0 billion or 0.2 percent to \$422.5 billion, down from the previously published 0.3 percent increase. This followed a 0.3 percent September increase. Transportation equipment, up twenty-five of the last twenty-six months, led the increase, \$0.6 billion or 0.4 percent to \$148.1 billion. Inventories of manufactured nondurable goods, up two of the last three months, increased \$0.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$264.8 billion. This followed a 0.5 percent September decrease. Chemical products, up four of the last five months, drove the increase, \$0.6 billion or 0.6 percent to \$98.4 billion. By stage of fabrication, October materials and supplies increased 0.6 percent in durable goods and decreased 0.2 percent in nondurable goods. Work in process decreased 0.2 percent in durable goods and 1.4 percent in nondurable goods. Finished goods increased 0.4 percent in durable goods and 0.8 percent in nondurable goods.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing.

"Virtually unchanged" indicates that the change is less than 0.05 percent for a percent increase or decrease.

## **Description of the survey**

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey, which is a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code. This survey provides statistics on a calendar-month basis for manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-ofmonth total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). Data published from the M3 survey are based on a panel of approximately 5,000 reporting units that represent approximately 3,100 companies and provide an indication of month-to-month change for the Manufacturing Sector. These reporting units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 92 industry categories, which are combined into 65 publication levels due to the small monthly panel size. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the reporting units in the M3 panel effectively represent the month-tomonth movements of all establishments that make up the category. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported or imputed in the M3 survey represent approximately 60 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2017 Economic Census, and these companies include roughly 61 percent of the manufacturing companies with \$500 million or more in shipments in the 2017 Economic Census. The companies for which shipments data are currently reported in the M3 survey represent approximately 51 percent of the total value of shipments for manufacturing establishments in the 2017 Economic Census. Statistics based on the M3 panel differ from the results that would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. The M3 panel is not based on a probability sample; therefore, the sampling

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errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to

represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
