Table Numbering

- Similar to Summary File 1
- “PCT” tables: **Population** subjects available down to the **census tract** level
 - 47 PCT tables
- “PCO” tables: **Population** subjects available down to the **county** level
 - 10 PCO tables
- “HCT” tables: **Housing** subjects available down to the **census tract** level
 - 14 HCT tables

Content

- Similar content as Summary File 1
- Summary File 1 race and Hispanic or Latino Origin tables, and redundant tables were removed

Potential Iteration Groups

- Total number of groups on list: 331
 - Total Population
 - 75 major race groups
 - American Indian and Alaska Native: 114 groups
 - Asian: 47 groups
 - Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander: 43 groups
 - Hispanic/not Hispanic: 51 groups

Thresholds – Two Types

- To be on the iteration list for SF 2:
 - American Indian and Alaska Native tribes/tribal groups: at least **7,000 people in the U.S. or included in SF 1**
 - All other race and Hispanic groups: at least **100 people in the U.S. or a group included in the Redistricting Data File**
- All tables are shown for each race group, American Indian and Alaska Native tribal grouping, and Hispanic or Latino group on the iteration list for which there are at least **100 people of that specific group in a particular geographic area**

Release Dates and Availability – State Files

- State-by-state flow basis, December 2011 through April 2012
- Available on:
 - AFF (detailed tables, quick tables, geographic comparison tables)
 - FTP (detailed tables only)
 - DVD (after National File is released)

Summary File 2 – National File

- Same data tables as state files
- Geographic levels: U.S., regions, divisions, states, CBSAs, and American Indian Areas
- Available on: AFF, FTP, and DVD
- Release: May 2012

Summary File 2 – Urban/Rural Update

- Urban/rural population and housing unit counts
- Lowest level of geography: Census tract
- Characteristics for urbanized areas and urban clusters
- Available on: AFF and FTP
- Release: January 2013

Accessing Summary File 2 using American FactFinder

- Go to: <http://factfinder2.census.gov> (or through the embargo site)
- Select:
 - Topics → Dataset: 2010 SF2 100% Data
 - Geographies
 - Population Groups
 - Then select a table - Ex. Profile of General Population and Housing Characteristics: 2010

Data Release Process

- Released on a state-by-state flow basis through April
 - Embargoed beginning on Tuesday mornings
 - Publicly released on Thursdays at 12:01 a.m.
- Week-ahead announcements
- National level figures will be released in May
