




The Economic Census

- The U.S. Government's official 5-year measure of American business and economy
- Part of the Census Bureau's mission to measure its people, places, and our economy
- The only source of detailed information by industry, geography, and products
- Provides the building blocks for GDP

Who Received a Form?


- About 4 million businesses received forms in November and December
- Includes employer businesses in all industries and communities
- Most very small businesses will not get a form





What's Asked and When is it Due?

- Forms include basic data about businesses as well as questions tailored to specific industries
- Forms are due by February 12, 2013
- Response is required by law









Reporting Options

Paper

- Businesses received one form for each location (unless requested electronic reporting)
- Form includes ID and password needed for electronic response and online tools
- Letter and inventory list sent to prior electronic reporters




- NEW online Direct Internet Reporting tool for single-location businesses

What Businesses Need to Know

Later this year, millions of businesses will receive a mailing package from the U.S. Census Bureau. Businesses will be asked to provide a range of operational and performance data for their companies' operations in 2012.

- · Paper. All businesses have the option to report on paper forms.
- · Electronic. All businesses have the option to report electronically. The mailing package businesses receive will have a User ID and Password to access the secure section of the Census Bureau Business Help Site.

Media/Associations

- Review the How to Prepare checklist for a general overview of what you need to prepare.
- Review the sample forms to see the kind of information requested.
- Identify where in the company this information is stored.
- Take a look at the Industry and Local Business Snapshots to see how the data are compiled.

In this year's Economic Census, new statistics are introduced to profile key company-wide characteristics of U.S. enterprises, such as innovation and globalization.


