The decennial census residence criteria say that people should be counted at their usual residence, which is defined as the place where they live and sleep most of the time. 





2030 Census Program for Experiments and Evaluations / 2040 Census

Some comments were considered innovative and valuable to pursue in the future.

- Not feasible for immediate action due to current policies or resources limitations.
- May contribute to experimental studies or evaluations to be conducted concurrently with the 2030 Census.





## Considered But Not Selected

Some comments were considered but not selected to pursue due to:

- Past research and subject matter expertise
- Not of a research nature
- Not aligned with the Census Bureau's mission

Example: "Do not contact households for which the Census Bureau already has a quality administrative record."

- We are committed to providing each household the opportunity to respond.
- Administrative records data may not align with current census question formats, such as race and ethnicity questions.
